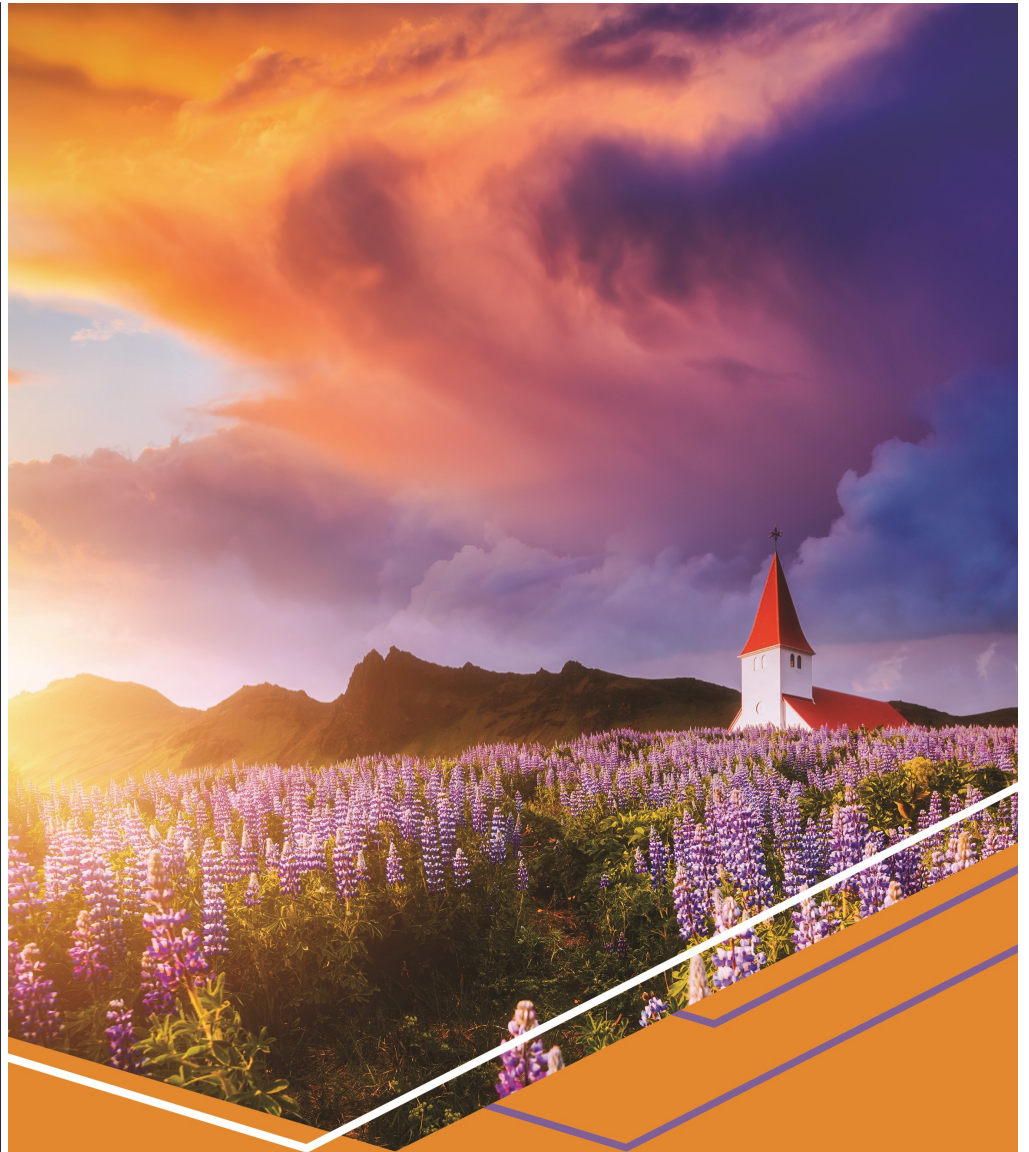

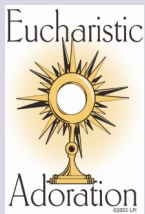

As the meeting minutes of the Parish Council and Finance Committee are released this weekend, you will see (at this time) our year shows collections and other income is above our expenses. Inflation has been hard on all consumers and it is hard on the Parish as well. Our Catholic Ministries Appeal shortage (\$6,500 month to catch-up) is a hard hit to our budget and will push us towards an end-of-year loss. If there is any way you might increase your tithing in the last month of our fiscal year, we may finish the year without a loss. *If each giving family could increase their tithe by \$5 a week in June, we should breakeven. I lean on faith and hope that we, the faithful, will get this done. Although I rely on your virtue, I trust the Lord to guide his Kingdom reflected in the charity of St. Isidore regardless of profit and loss.*
